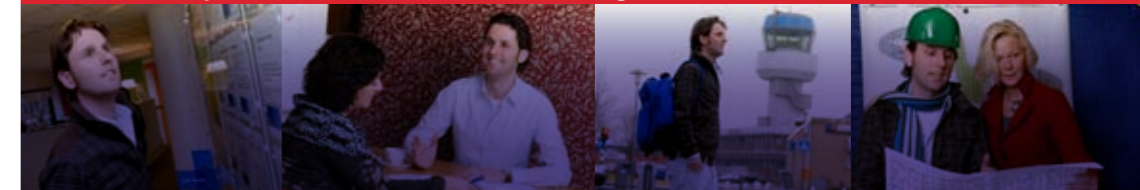

- your language skills

- personal skills and competencies
- additional information (sideline activities and hobbies)

## Europass Certificate supplement

The Europass Certificate supplement provides a general description of the coursework and credits on your intermediate vocational education diploma, either in English or Dutch. It

Europass helps you during job interviews and selection procedures in the Netherlands and other European countries. You use your Europass to store a well-organised record of the knowledge, skills, competencies and diplomas you have acquired at home and abroad.

There are five Europass documents:

- Europass CV
- Europass Language passport
- Europass Mobility
- Europass Certificate supplement
- Europass Diploma supplement

Europass is an initiative of the European Union designed to promote mobility in working and studying. These are official documents that are available in every European language and country. Europass is recognised throughout Europe.

## Europass CV

The Europass CV considerably simplifies applying for jobs in Europe as well as the Netherlands. It is a model CV which you can use to present yourself when searching for a job, an internship or a place in an educational programme. During your interview, the Europass CV offers a good illustration of your knowledge and abilities.

## Europass Language passport

When you plan on working or studying in a foreign country, your language skills are very important. The Europass Language passport enables you to describe your writing, speaking, reading and listening proficiency. You use the Europass Language passport when you wish to provide detailed information about your language skills during an interview. ## Europass Mobility

The Europass Mobility provides information about your internship, vocational training or study in Europe. This provides a potential employer or company offering an internship a good impression of your activities abroad, how much time you spent there and where you were.

Essentially, the Europass Mobility is issued by your educational institute and signed by the organisation where you had your internship or studied. In some cases you will need to request it yourself.
