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ESTONIA

- small country

- 1.3 million in habitants

- sometimes known as " high-digitalised" country



- Three aspects
- a) Social security
- b) Taxation issues
- c) Labour law coverage

- Social security theoretically easy where is the place of work!
- The place of work (or economical activity) is most important!
- Remote work (platform work) is this always enough?
- Free movement of workers physical movement is it really necessary?
- What about movement between different platforms?

Taxation

- How to avoid double taxation (income tax)?

- What about the other obligations (e.g. property tax; car tax etc.?)
- Main idea tax resident and worldwide income vs non-tax resident?

Labour law

- applicable legislation – where a person ususally works

- agreement on applicable legislation
- mandatory rules, that can not be avoided

- Free movement of workers and remote work – changes or adaption is needed?

- Physical movement – is it still need nowadays?
