What is remote working?






Remote work is a type of flexible working arrangement that allows people to work a location outside of the office.

It is based on the concept that work does not need to be done in a specific place to be executed successfully.














There are many different models for remote work

According to a recent <u>national survey</u> on remote

• **95%** of employees surveyed want to continue working remotely post-pandemic

32% would like to work remotely on a daily basis

• **53%** would like to work remotely several times

• **24%** would consider relocating based on their experience of remote working over the past

• **Hybrid** is the preferred option for the majority of employers who have decided their postpandemic strategy

- ► Social Isolation
- ► Keeping motivated
- > Lack of engagement and collaboration with colleagues
- ► Technical issues and workspace issues
- \succ Over-working and difficulty separating home and work life
- > Hybrid model can lead to a 'two-tier' workforce

- The ability to collaborate with team members in a remote setting
- The ability to focus and self-motivate
- Time management skills
- Adaptability





Remote work in Europe





Hard to get exact stats on that, but as a rough estimate using LinkedIn alone with remote search enabled - in December there were 55,000 remote jobs open in Europe (or EEA). Today it's showing 60,000 remote jobs in EEA, that's 720,000 a year and growing at 8-10% every 2 months






